- Complete residency determination https://ncresidency.cfnc.org/residencyInfo/ This is now required with college applications.
- Make sure to submit school specific scholarship by mid-October
- October 7: SAT (location is determined at the time of registration)
- October 14: Homecoming
- October 20: Order Cap/Gowns and class rings during all three lunches or online www.jostens.com; if you have questions contact Ms. Heidi Anthony-Cash, Room 222 hanthony@lincoln.k12.nc.us
 - The total cost for required graduation items is \$65.00; \$30.00 for cap, gown, and tassel; \$35.00 diploma items.
 - There are additional graduation items that can be ordered, and all seniors will receive this packet in homeroom.
 - If needed, you should plan to purchase any appropriate LHS sanctioned honor society items: NHS, Beta, NTHS, Tri-M, NAHS, Kitty Hawk Society, and Latin Honors. Latin Honors cords will be \$5.00 (each) with a possibility of three cords.

- Finalize early decision college applications this is to find out early acceptance into specific colleges.
- December 1: Complete FAFSA forms https://fafsa.gov (This is how you can receive financial aid in college.)
- December 2: SAT (location is determined at the time of registration)
- December 9: ACT (location is determined at the time of registration)
- December 15-21: fall semester exams and the end of the first/fall semester
- December 21: make up day for missed exams
- If you have not ordered your cap and gown before the end of 1st semester break you will pay a \$15.00 late fee.
- Any senior that is an early graduate must order C/G before leaving at the end of the first semester on December 21.

- January 8: first day of spring semester

February 2024

- February 10: ACT (location is determined at the time of registration)
- February 23: Yearbook cost will increase to \$80.00, and you can no longer order books with name stamps on the cover.
- Prom tickets will go on sale during February; price to be determined.

- Cap/Gowns and class rings will be delivered during mid-March during all three lunches. If you have any senior debts your graduation items will be held until those are cleared.

- Senior surveys to be completed with your guidance counselor.
- May 1: Senior Cap and Gown Class Picture, Senior Lunch, and LHS Awards Day
 - Senior awards day is a <u>mandatory</u> event if you are walking in the graduation ceremony; this includes the first semester early graduates as well. The cap and gown picture and senior lunch are optional events. Picture packets are due at the time of the picture and cost is \$25.00.
 - Seniors must report to the new gym lobby by 7:30 AM; you must be dressed according to the graduation dress code with cap, gown, solid black tassel, and sanctioned honor cords only (NHS, Beta, NTHS, Tri-M, NAHS, Kitty Hawk).
 - Dress Code Male: white long sleeve button down collared dress shirt, black dress pants, black dark tie, black dress shoes, and solid black socks.
 - Dress Code Female: solid black dress and solid black closed-toe shoes flats preferred due to extensive walking.
 - **Absolutely NO** boots, work boots, flip flops of any style or brand, sling back shoes, sandals, jeans, black colored jeans, strapless dresses, halter dress, or sheer dresses, or bow ties.
 - All clothing <u>MUST</u> meet the LHS dress code. If you do not meet this dress code or are late, you will not participate in the picture or awards day.
 - Senior Awards Day will start promptly at 12:45 PM and seniors will sit in alphabetical order.
- May 20 June 3: Graduation Ceremony DVD's will go on sale for \$20.00 from Ms. Roberson in the library. These must be prepaid to order.
- May 17-May 23: spring semester exams and end of the spring/second semester
- May 23: Last day of school and make up missed exams
- All Chromebooks need to be turned in before exams end to receive your graduation tickets on time.
- All fees and debts must be cleared before graduation practice or you will not receive your graduation tickets.
- Senior Handshake Picture order form \$20.00 these must be returned at graduation practice.
- May 24: Graduation Practice at 10:00 AM sharp, new gym, casual dress attire this is a mandatory event.
- Graduation tickets will be distributed at the end of practice. (6 tickets new gym and 5 tickets old gym)
- May 25: Saturday Graduation at 10:00 AM inside the new gym. Same attire as senior awards day and only LHS sanctioned honor regalia may be worn: NHS, Beta, Latin Honors, NTHS, Tri-M, NAHS, and Kitty Hawk. This means no outside non-sanctioned honor organizations.
