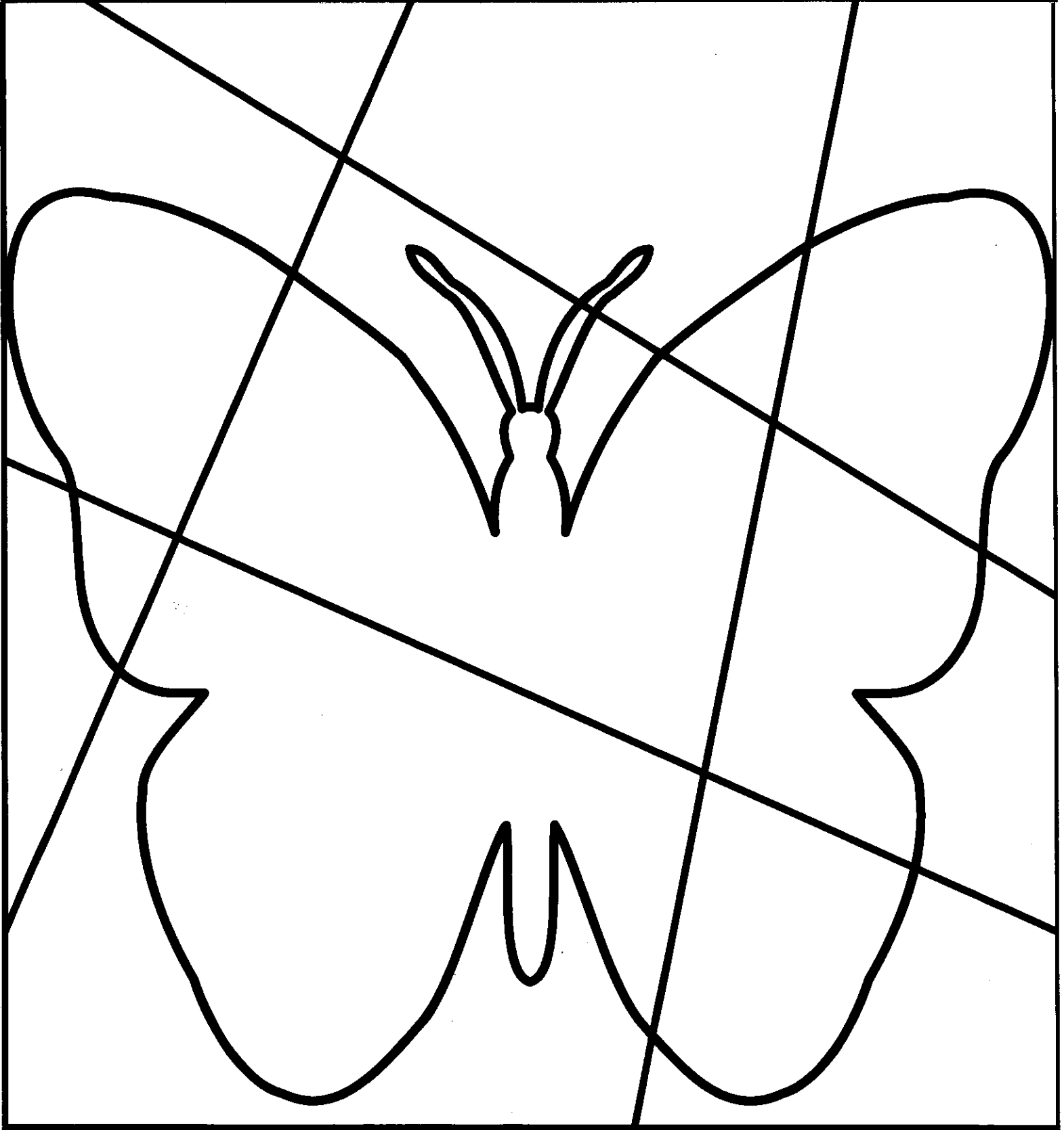


Spring Coloring Sheets

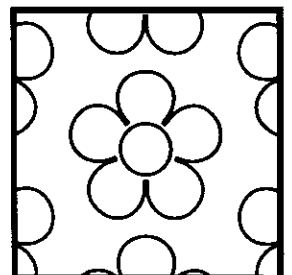
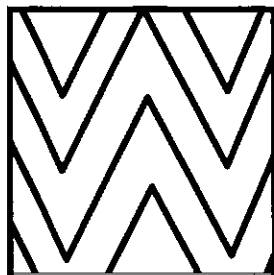
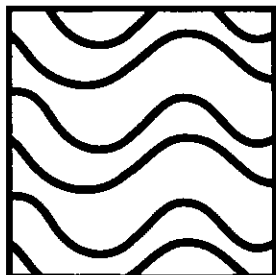
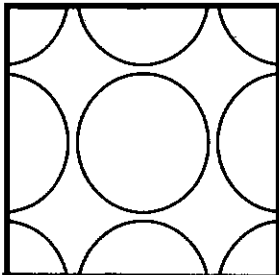
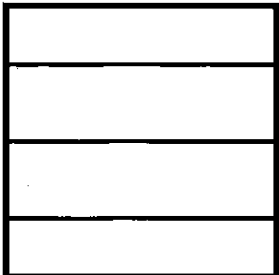
How - To

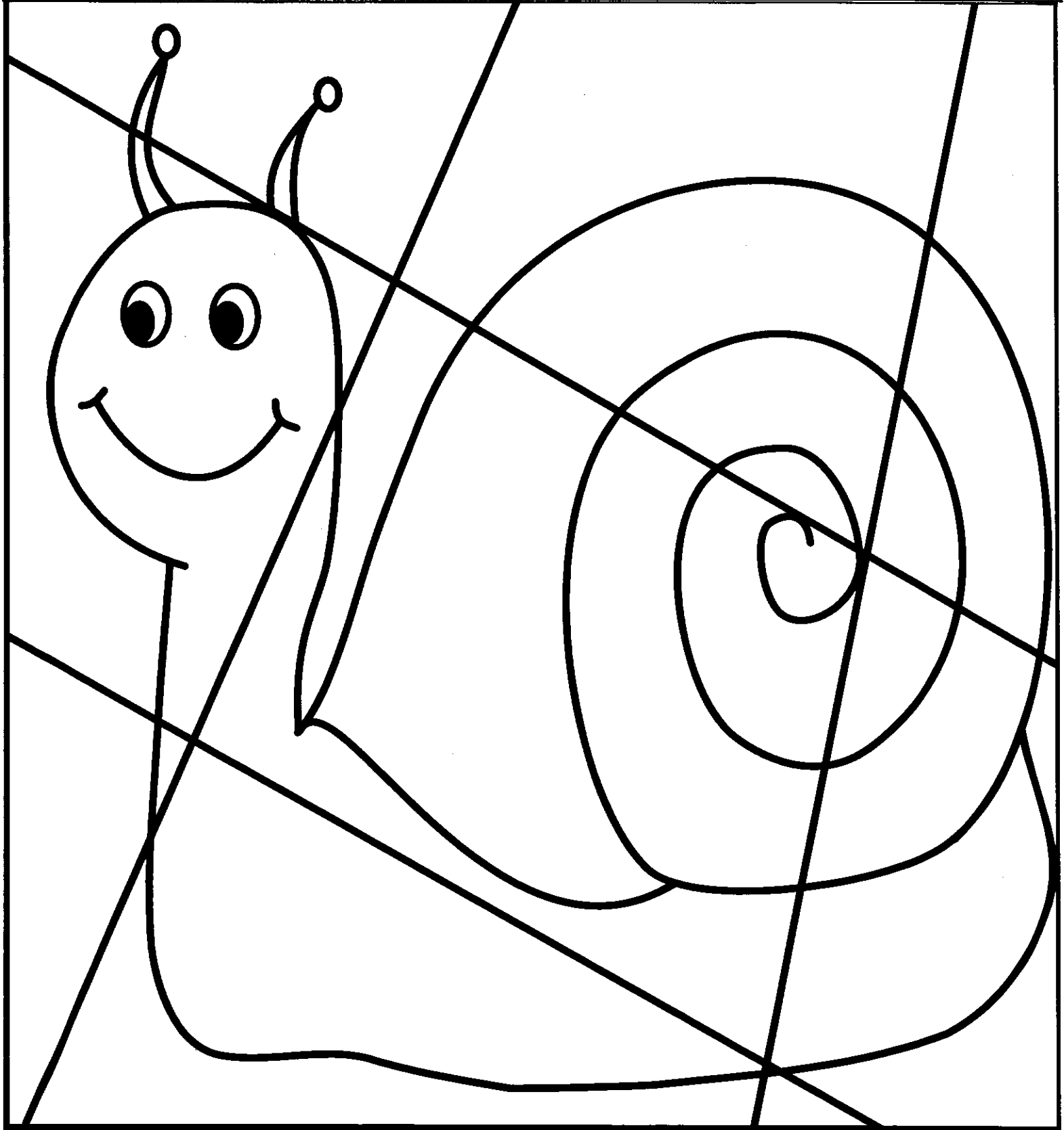

2. Color all the shapes and patterns. Use crayons, colored pencils or markers.
3. Cut out the large rectangle at the top with the finished work. Display for all to see!
4. Write a story about spring. It can be what you like most about spring, or tell me about your favorite plant or plants you like to see blossom in the springtime, or you can try to persuade me to believe spring is the best of the four seasons.
