

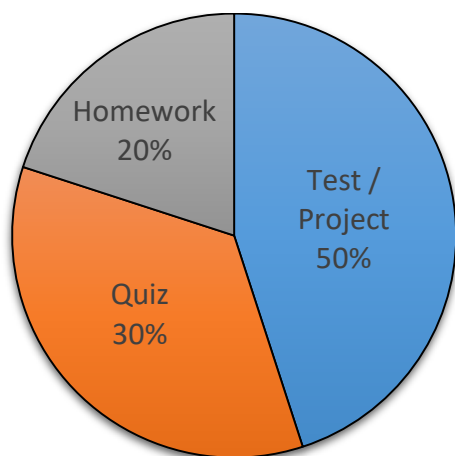


WELCOME!
