

In this course, students will progress from the standards learned in NC Math I and II. In addition, NC Math III extends to include absolute value equations and inequalities, inverse functions,

logarithmic and exponential functions, rational expressions and equations, polynomial functions, trigonometric functions and the unit circle. Also included are the geometric concepts of centers of triangles, quadrilaterals, circles, composite volume/surface area and statistical studies which incorporate designs of surveys, types of sampling and margin of error.
