Exams: Tests are given every couple of weeks as each unit is completed, see schedule on back.

-Students will be given a test result form that <u>must</u> be signed by the student **AND** parent/guardian.

-<u>Final exam</u>: There will be a state issued Final Exam. It will be worth 20% of your grade. There will be no exemptions from this test.

Grading Scale: 50% tests, 40% quizzes, labs, activities, 10% homework

Supplies: paper, pencil, 3-ring binder, dividers, scientific calculator (graphing calculators are acceptable but **not** required). *You must bring these items to class every day.*

Cell phones/ipods/personal digital devices: these items should NOT be used for texting or communicating with others at any time during class! Personal technology may occasionally be used to access the internet to research topics and only when specific permission is given. At the beginning of class, students will be asked to "Power Down" their mobile devices. Cell phones and other mobile devices must be silenced or turned off and put in the student's book bag. Students using these devices inappropriately will be given a warning and are expected to put the device away. Continued misuse of any digital device will result in a discipline referral.

Absences: you have 5 school days to make up any missed work/tests/quizzes due to an excused absence. Check online for assignments/notes that have been posted.

-I will give you the make-up work, but it is your responsibility to complete it by the due date!!

-tests and quizzes can only be made up after school within 5 days of your absence or you will receive a zero.
