Players Expectations:

- 1. Be at practice: Excused absences **may** limit playing in games. Unexcused absences **will** result in disciplinary action.
- 2. Give maximum effort and focus every day: Players who fail to provide focus and effort tend to be a distraction for the team and **may** face disciplinary action.
- 3. Maintain a positive attitude: Attitudes are contagious. Players who display negative attitudes, or who cause conflict among the team **will** face disciplinary action.
- 4. Be role models: Players who fail to follow school rules, who are disrespectful or represent our team poorly, **will** face disciplinary action.
- 5. Maintain academics: Performing below a player's academic ability **may** result in disciplinary action.
- 6. Be honest: Activities such as lying or stealing will result in disciplinary action.

Disciplinary Actions:

- 1. Verbal warning.
- 2. Extra conditioning.
- 3. Removal from practice.
- 4. Suspension from a game.
- 5. Dismissal from the team.

Attendance Policy:

Attendance at practice is mandatory if a player is at school. Players are expected to be at school every day unless they have an injury or illness requiring a doctor visit or a family emergency. Players who do not practice because of injury must have permission from a coach or a doctor's note. Players who leave school early are required to speak to a coach **BEFORE** they leave. Players who do not participate in practice due to injury **may** be denied playing in the games.

Parent expectations:

- 1. Make every effort to have your player at all practices and games.
- 2. Model respectful behavior and display good sportsmanship.
- 3. Questions and concerns are welcome. Conversations between coaches and parents must be private, only about your child, and **never on the day of a game**.
- 4. Do not distract players during a practice or game.
- 5. Try to be positive! Attitudes are contagious. Threats and vulgarities are not acceptable.
- 6. Pick your child up within 15 minutes of the end of a game or practice.

Violating the parent expectations may result in a parent being barred from practices and games. A player may be removed from a game, receive a suspension from a game or practices, or dismissed from the team due to parental violations of this contract.
