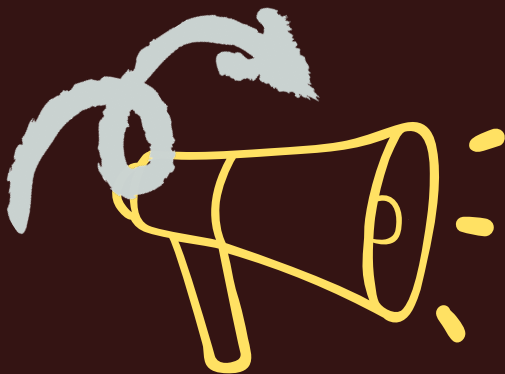
Checkout

LATE BOOK NOTICES

Each month I do my best to send out reminders of late books and/or books that have unpaid fines attached to them. When students are sent an overdue book notice, it is really just a notice. I understand we all live busy lives and books can easily be misplaced. Sometimes students strongly feel they returned a book that they received a notice about. No problem, I always tell students that I will look for the book in the library and for them to also look at home, in the car, in bookbags, etc. If students have learned to read call numbers, they too will help look for the book in the library. It could very well have been misplaced—it just happens sometimes. If your child knows or you know that a book has been damaged or lost, then please let me know. I prefer the book to be paid for or a new copy of the exact book to be bought.
