

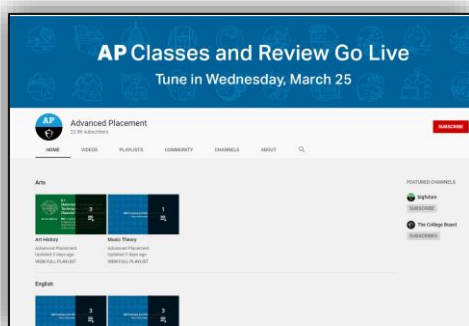
Daily AP Review Online Classes
