This call is to inform you revisions made to LCS Board Policy 3450 impacting all high school students graduating in 2020 and beyond.

In addition to Valedictorian and Salutatorian recognition during graduation, Lincoln County Schools' will also recognize students through the Latin Honors program. For students graduating during the 2019-2020 school year, the following distinctions will also be given:

1. Students with a 3.95 weighted grade point average shall receive the distinction of cum laude.
2. Students with a 4.25 weighted grade point average shall receive the distinction of magna cum laude.
3. Students with a 4.40 or higher weighted grade point average shall receive the distinction of summa cum laude.
