Exams prepared by teachers will be administered face to face in all other courses. Students who meet exam exemption criteria are not required to take the teacher exam. However, students who earn an exemption are encouraged to take the exam which will only be used to improve the student’s final grade for the course.

May 26th - June 2nd will be designated for completion of course work, make up work submissions, teacher made and state exams, and unit recovery. Class period attendance will be taken daily. If students are not on a school campus for a review session or end of semester assessment, they will be marked absent.
