<b>Affable</b>	<b><u>ADJ</u></b>	<b>Friendly, pleasant, easy to talk to</b>	The waiter was <b><u>affable</u></b> because he was well-mannered.
<b>Droll</b>	<b><u>ADJ</u></b>	<b>Amusingly odd or comical</b>	The <b><u>droll</u></b> troll made us all laugh.
<b>Scruple</b>	<b><u>Noun</u></b>	<b>An uneasy feeling arising from one's conscience or principles</b>	I felt a <b><u>scruple</u></b> after I cheated on the math test.
<b>Elude</b>	<b><u>Verb</u></b>	<b>To escape especially by means of cleverness or skill</b>	I <b><u>eluded</u></b> my five star wanted level.

<b>Solicitously</b>	<b><u>Adverb</u></b>	<b>With an expression of care or concern</b>	My mother <u>solicitously</u> looked at my sister when she fell down.
<b>Imperative</b>	<b><u>ADJ/Ad</u></b> <b><u>v.</u></b>	<b>Absolutely necessary</b>	It is <u>imperative</u> to breath if you want to survive.
<b>Stamina</b>	<b><u>Noun</u></b>	<b>Physical or moral strength; endurance</b>	The man had great <u>stamina</u> when he ran the marathon.
<b>Deplorable</b>	<b><u>ADJ</u></b>	<b>Deeply regrettable; unfortunate</b>	It was <u>deplorable</u> that we had to attend a funeral.
