Concerns:

The cafeteria is running out of food. Third grade is not getting food that is on the menu. However, Kindergarten, who goes after third, always gets hot food that is on the menu. What can be done to make sure enough food is prepared each day? **Discussed issue with Mrs. Henson, she will make sure menu items for the day are available.**

K-3 will still use LetterLand for Phonics/ Vocabulary.

Mr. K is going to think about canceling the “No Recess if you have PE this day” rule for the rest of the year...he is thinking about it and will let us know. Also, he will think about that rule for next year whether it will be or not. He will let us know.

We will have 2 full time Speech Language Therapists next year. Amy Savage and Lindsay Tate
